

Flu Vaccine

We are anticipating the flu vaccine will be available here at Uraidla Family Practice from early to mid April.

As in previous years we will have the government funded vaccine available for those eligible through the National Immunisation Program and the private vaccine for those opting to have the immunisation privately.

If you choose to have the vaccine privately your consult will be bulk billed by the doctor, there will be a fee of \$16.50 payable at the time of vaccination to cover the vaccine cost.

We will take bookings for flu immunisations once the vaccines have been received, we understand that the immunisation is likely to be in high demand this flu season.

People eligible for the fully funded immunisation include (but are not limited to):

- ◆ Older adults (65+)
- ◆ Indigenous Australians (6 months and over)
- ◆ Pregnant Women
- ◆ People aged 6 months and over with medical conditions that can lead to complications from influenza for example:
 - Diabetes
 - Cardiac disease
 - Chronic respiratory conditions
